We agree and pledge...

- To** support the health and welfare of youth, and the laws of the State of Washington by not selling, giving, or otherwise supplying alcohol to anyone we know to be under the age of 21 while in our company, home, or our care.
- To** actively chaperone parties in our home where those in attendance are under the age of 21.
- To** welcome the calls and/or visits of parents and/or guardians of children coming to our home, and to assist them with details regarding times, location, and supervision.
- To** call the parent or guardian of a child if a problem arises while they are in my/our care.
- To** make myself available via telephone while a gathering involving children under the age of 21 is taking place on my property.
- To** share the contents of this pledge with everyone in my family.
- To** do what I can to ensure the welfare of any children on my property to the best of my ability, including:
 - preventing from driving or leaving, and notifying the appropriate parent or guardian of any youth I believe:
 - has consumed alcohol or
 - has been using drugs of any kind

Please consider this pledge carefully. Remember, it is against Washington State Law...

“...for any person to sell, give, or otherwise supply liquor to any person under the age of twenty-one years or permit any person under that age to consume liquor on his or her premises or on any premises under his or her control. For the purposes of this subsection, "premises" includes real property, houses, buildings, and other structures, and motor vehicles and watercraft. A violation of this subsection is a gross misdemeanor punishable as provided for in chapter [9A.20](#) RCW.”

“Gross misdemeanor. Every person convicted of a gross misdemeanor defined in Title [9A](#) RCW shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for a maximum term fixed by the court of not more than one year, or by a fine in an amount fixed by the court of not more than five thousand dollars, or by both such imprisonment and fine.”
